2.	Identification of plantation sites (Potential Area for plantation)	 With the issue of benefit sharing now being made flexible, the BPMS are to start reworking for identification of potential areas for plantation BPMs are to ensure that the VPIC is engaged in the discussion and decisions in identifying the potential areas for plantation. All BPMs are to complete the exercises at earliest so that surveying of the sites can be started immediately, as advance work has to be completed by March, 2023 Identification of land for plantation is to be highly prioritised for completion before the timeline and ongoing Micro planning activity may be slowed down if the need requires. 			
3.	Survey and demarcation.	 In cases where forest lands are falling outside the village boundary but is owned by the community or individual residing in the village, such lands can also be taken up for plantation, if provided. The village boundary, however, remains the same and in no way can be changed. Survey is to be completed latest by the month of Feb, 2023 so that advance work can be completed by March, 2023 Maps of the surveyed sites is to be prepared by GIS personnel 			
4.	VPIC as the main implementing committee	 As the Committee has been constituted as the main institution for implementation of MegLIFE. Therefore, all BPMs are to ensure that the VPIC is kept engaged in all matters relating to implementation of MegLIFE activities in their village. As per the functioning and responsibility, the GB is to meet once a year and EC is to meet once in three months or whenever the need arises before that. Minutes of every meeting are to be maintained and recorded in register. All VPIC minutes will be captured under MIS in future. Finance component to sort out the issue of purchase of registers for
